of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. He shall be compensated at the rate of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600) per month for such part time as is required, commencing June 1, 1964; said compensation to be paid out of the Trunk Highway Fund.
