NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF DANVERS, MINNESOTA,  
ORDAINS

Section 1. Commencing with the 1964 village election, the regular village election of the Village of Danvers shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
