P R O C L A M A T I O N

- WHEREAS, the number of accidents and highway fatalities is increasing, and
- WHEREAS, these accidents with their consequent loss of life, personal injury and property damage is of the utmost concern to the Governor of Minnesota, the State Legislature and other State officials, and
- WHEREAS, one important means of reducing the number of accidents now and in the future is by providing adequate driver training instruction and incentive for the young people of the State to become better drivers, and
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Junior Chamber of Commerce and the Fridley Junior Chamber of Commerce are sponsoring the annual Teenage Safe Driving Road-c-o on June 10, 1964.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Holmberg, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby declare the week of June 7 - 13 as

"TEENAGE SAFE DRIVING WEEK"

and hereby urge all citizens of this State, and particularly the teenage drivers, to exercise good driving habits so as to make the highways safer for all of the citizens of the State of Minnesota.
