PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the loss in skill and earning power of every man and woman who suffers a preventable work injury impoverishes still more a Nation already at war against poverty, and

WHEREAS, leaders of American business, labor, agriculture, science, government and safety organizations will convene in Washington for the President's Conference on Occupational Safety, and

WHEREAS, President Lyndon B. Johnson has designated the Conference week of June 21-27 as Job Safety Week to enlist the natural leadership in each worker, farmer, teacher or businessman,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvraag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 21-27 as

"JOB SAFETY WEEK"

in Minnesota, and call upon every Minnesotan to work safely and to safeguard his fellow workers, confident that a week's trial will condone the practices of safety all year round.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, and of the State, the one hundred seventh.
