PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the maintenance and development of recreational and play-ground areas in urban centers is of great concern, and

WHEREAS, the growth of population and the encroachment on urban green areas by expressways has created serious situations, and

WHEREAS, public knowledge of and concern for such vital problems is necessary to their solution,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the first day of Summer, June 21, as

"RECREATION DAY"

in Minnesota, and do urge all citizens to appreciate the importance of green space and parks for recreation and beauty space in our urban areas and to seek solutions to our increasingly complicated problems of urban growth and development.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this sixteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, and of the State, the one hundred seventh.
