ORDINANCE NO. 186

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLACE OF SAUK RAPIDS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND MOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

Section 15:32 (1) The governing body of the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, resolves to have the following land included within the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota:

The Southwest Guerter of the Northeast Cuarter of the Southeast Cuarter (SW2 of NE2 of SE2) of Section 23, Twp., 36 North, Renge 31 West, also known as Cross Addition, Penton County, Minnesota.

- (2) The quantity of land embraced with the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 10 acros.
