ORDINANCE NO. 186

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN FLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

Section 15:32 (1) The governing body of the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, resolves to have the following land included within the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota:

The Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 23, Twp., 36 North, Range 31 West, also known as Cross Addition, Benton County, Minnesota.


(2) The quantity of land embraced with the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 10 acres.

(3) The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government; (3) that the territory is completely surrounded by said Village.


(4) Therefore, the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property herein before described by and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

(5) This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing Certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and Secretary of State, from and after its passage and publication.

Passed by the Village Council this 21st day of April, 1964.


