## ORDINANCE NO. 434 (Special)

An Ordinance extending the corporate limits of the City of Willmar, a municipal corporation of the State of Minnesota to include certain land not exceeding 200

Be it ordained by the City of Willmar as follows:

Section I. Petition. Whereas, a petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Willmar, a municipal corporation of the State of Minnesota by the sole owner and all persons having any interest therein, to have certain real property, hereinafter described included within the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and

Whereas, it is proposed to annex by virtue hereof to the said City of Willmar, said property, all of which is in Kandiyohi County in said State, and

Section II. Land Embraced. The quantity of land embraced within the following description is approximately

.4 acres, and Whereas, the said property is described as follows, to-

The South 90 feet of the North 114 feet of the West 173 feet of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW¼ SW¼ NE¼) of Section 22, Township 119, Range 35, subject to the public road right of way along the West side of said tract,

Now, therefor, the City Council of the City of Willmar hereby determines, ordains and declares as follows:

That the annexation will be to the best interest of the City of Willmar, Minnesota, and of the territory affected.
