EXTRACT OF THE MINUTES OF MEETING  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
JORDAN, MINNESOTA

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Jordan, Minnesota, was held at the City Hall in said City on Tuesday June 23, 1964, at 7:30 P. M. with the following members present:

Vice-President Math Busch, Alderman George Johnson, John Krautkremer, Roland Nachbar, Earl H. Hedstrom.

Alderman Nachbar introduced the following ordinance and moved its adoption:

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS ADJACENT THE CITY INCORPORATED LIMITS OF THE CITY OF JORDAN, MINNESOTA, AND OWNED BY SAID CITY OF JORDAN, MINNESOTA, TO SAID CITY

The City Council of the City of Jordan, Minnesota, do ordain:

The following described parcels of land abutting on and owned by the City of Jordan, Minnesota, are hereby annexed to said City of Jordan, Minnesota;

- (1) The Westerly Three Hundred Feet (300') of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Seventeen (17), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114), Range twenty-three (23), Scott County, Minnesota, containing 9.1 acres, more or less
- (2) The Westerly Three Hundred Feet (300') of the North ten (10) acres of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section Seventeen (17), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114), Range twenty-three (23), Scott County, Minnesota, containing 2.3 acres more or less
- (3) All that portion of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Fourteen (114), Range 23, Scott County, Minnesota, lying southeasterly of Chicago & Northwestern Railway right-of-way containing 39.6 acres, more or less
- (4) All that portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 114, Range 23, Scott County, Minnesota, lying southeasterly of Chicago & Northwestern Railway right-of-way, containing 10.9 acres, more or less
- (5) All that portion of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 114, Range 23, Scott County, Minnesota, lying southeasterly of Chicago & Northwestern Railway right-of-way containing 32.7 acres, more or less, EXCEPT the following described tract: Beginning at a point on the South Line of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  56' East of the West Line of said quarter, which point is on the East bank of Sand Creek; thence East on said South Line 478'; thence northwesterly at an angle of 66 degrees to said South Line 437.9' to a point 400' north of said South Line; thence due West 46' to the East bank of Sand Creek; thence southwesterly along East bank of said Sand Creek to point of beginning

(6) All that portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 114, Range 23, Scott County, Minnesota, lying southeasterly of Chicago & Northwestern Railway right-of-way containing 25.4 acres, more or less, EXCEPT the following described tract: Commencing at the SW corner of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 18, Township 114, Range 23; thence North along West Line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  250' to a point; thence North 62 degrees 30' East 255' to a point; thence North 61 degrees 12 minutes East 1,247' to a point on the East Line of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , said point being 705' North of the SE corner of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; thence South to the said S. E. corner; thence West to point of beginning
