

ANNEXATION PETITION

AN ORDINANCE PREPARED BY CORPORATE MEMBERS OF THE
VILLAGE OF CARLISLE, KANSAI COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO
INCORPORATE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200
ACRES IN AREA.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated the 26th day of November,
1963, respecting annexation of the territory described below,
was duly presented to the Council and filed in the office of
the Village Clerk on December 5, 1963; and

WHEREAS, said petition for annexation was signed by the
President and Secretary of the P.P.B. Co., a corporation,
which corporation is the sole owner of the said territory de-
scribed below; and

WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of said petition for
annexation was filed in the office of the Township Clerk of the
Township of Carlisle on December 11, 1963, and in the office
of the County Auditor in and for Kandiyohi County, Minnesota on
December 9, 1963, the said Township and County being the same
to which all of the land to be annexed is located; and

WHEREAS, a true and correct copy of said petition for
annexation, together with the required certificances of filing
the same and the other required items, have been duly filed
with the Minnesota Municipal Commission on or about December 12,
1963, and copies of the Certificate of Filing have been duly
mailed to the County Auditor and the Minnesota Secretary
of State; and

WHEREAS, more than 30 days have elapsed since said petition
and other required papers were filed with said Minnesota
Municipal Commission, and no written objections to the annexa-
tion from any municipal subdivision or person, have been filed
or submitted to the said Commission or the Village of Carlisle;
and

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that the
annexation of the territory hereinafter described will be to
the best interest of the municipality and of the territory
affected, and said territory is so conditioned as properly
to be subjected to village government;

THE TOWNSHIP, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF CAMBRIDGE MINNESOTA,

Section 1. Declaration. It is hereby determined that the territory described below exists upon the Village of Cambridge and is so conditioned as to properly be subject to Village government, and that the corporation thereof would be to the best interest of the Village of Cambridge and the territory affected.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the Village of Cambridge are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 26, Township 36, Range 23, Isanti County, Minnesota, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the East and West Quarter Line of said Section 26, distant 51 rods East of the Southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter, thence East on said Quarter Line a distance of 531.3 feet to the West right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 65, as now established and laid out, (said East and West Quarter Line of said Section 26, bearing North 90° East assumed), thence Northwestly along said West right-of-way line of Highway No. 65 to a point that is 207.84 foot North of right angles measured from said East and West Quarter Line of said Section 26, thence North 90° West and parallel with said East and West Quarter Line a distance of 572 feet, more or less, to a point that is 785.4 foot West of the West right-of-way line of the Great Northern railroad as now established and laid out, thence South 29°20'35" West a distance of 49.17 feet, thence North 90° West and parallel to said East and West Quarter Line a distance of 260 feet, more or less, to the East right-of-way line of Isanti County Road No. 39, thence Southwesterly along said East right-of-way line 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods, more or less, to its intersection with East and West Quarter Line, thence North 90° East along said East and West Quarter Line, a distance of 264 feet to the point of beginning and there to terminate. Excepting, however, the following tract, to-wit: That part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 26, Township 36, Range 23, Isanti County, Minnesota, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the South line of said Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter, distant 51 rods East of the Southwest corner of Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter (said South line bearing North 90° East, assumed) thence North 90° West, along said South line 18 feet to the actual point of beginning of the tract to be herein described; thence North 0°30', 62 feet, thence North 81°9'30" West 183 feet, to the East line of County Road No. 39, thence South 25°64'30" West along said East Road line, 111.3 feet to its intersection with said South Line of Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter, thence North 90° East along said South Line 246 feet, to the actual point of beginning.

That there is included in said description any and all right, title and interest the owner of said property may have in and to the parcels of land abutting the above described parcel which are now subject to highway or public road connections for State Road Highway No. 69 on the easterly boundary thereof and Second County Road No. 39, on the westerly boundary thereof.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance in the office of the Secretary of State, in the office of the Minnesota Municipal Commission, and the office of the Cass County Auditor, all pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Amended Section 414.03, as amended.

Section 4. Effective Date of Amendment. Amendment shall be complete from and after the date when certified copies of this Ordinance have been filed as directed in Section 3, hereto.

PETITION FOR APPROPRIATION

TO THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE, ISANTI COUNTY,
MINNESOTA:

THE UNDERSIGNED OWNER OF THE TERRITORY DESCRIBED DESCRIBED, hereby requests and respectfully petitions the Village Council to annex said territory to the Village of Cambridge, and to extend the Village boundaries to include the same, and for that purpose respectfully states:

1. That the territory to be annexed consists wholly of unplotted lands which do not exceed 260 acres in area. That all of said lands lie entirely within the Township of Cambridge, in the County of Isanti and State of Minnesota, and the description of said land is as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 36, Range 23, Isanti County, Minnesota, described as follows; Beginning at a point on the East and West Quarter Line of said Section 28, distant 51 rods East of the Southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter, thence East on said Quarter Line a distance of 551.3 feet to the West right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 65, as now established and laid out, (said East and West Quarter Line of said Section 28, bearing North 90° East assumed), thence Northeasterly along said West right-of-way line of Highway No. 65 to a point that is 307.84 feet North at right angles measured from said East and West Quarter Line of said Section 28, thence North 90° West and parallel with said East and West Quarter Line a distance of 572 feet, more or less, to a point that is 785.4 feet West of the West right-of-way line of the Great Northern railroad as now established and laid out, thence South 29°20'38" West a distance of 49.17 feet, thence North 90° West and parallel to said East and West Quarter Line a distance of 260 feet, more or less, to the East right-of-way line of Isanti County Road No. 39, thence Southwesterly along said East right-of-way line 124 rods, more or less, to its intersection with said East and West Quarter Line, thence North 90° East along said East and West Quarter Line, a distance of 264 feet to the point of beginning and thence to terminate. Excepting however, the following exact, to-wit: That part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 28, Township 36, Range 23, Isanti County, Minnesota, described as

follows: Commencing at a point on the South line of said Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter, distant 51 rods East of the Southwest corner of Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter (said South line bearing North 90° East, assumed) thence North 90° West, along said South line 18 feet to the actual point of beginning of the tract to be herein described; thence North 0°00', 62 feet, thence North 01°30" West 183 feet, to the East line of County Road No. 33, thence South 35°54'30" West along said East Road line, 111.3 feet to its intersection with said South line of Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter, thence North 90° East along said South line 246 feet, to the actual point of beginning.

The said petitioner intends to include in said annexation, any and all right, title and interest, it may have in and to the parcels of land abutting its parcel which are now subject to highway or public road easements for State Trunk Highway No. 65, on the Eastwally boundary thereof, and County Road No. 33, on the Westerly boundary thereof.

2. That the territory described above, abuts upon the Village of Cambridge limits and none of it is presently a part of any incorporated city, village or borough.

3. That all of said territory is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to municipal government, and the undersigned believes that it would be for the best interests of the undersigned and for the best interests of the Village of Cambridge if said territory were included within the Village of Cambridge and annexed thereto.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned respectfully petitions the Village Council of Cambridge, to include the land heretofore described within the boundaries of the Village of Cambridge, and to annex said territory by ordinance, in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 414.03, (2), as amended.
