He shall be compensated on a reasonable fee basis, which shall include all clerical and other necessary office expenses, incurred by counsel, together with necessary travel expenses, said compensation to be paid from the funds of the Milk and Dairy Investigation Fund upon verified claims therefor presented by the appointee. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General and until the matters hereinbefore mentioned are completed.
