ORDINANCE NO. 41
AN ORDINANCE ELECTING
TO HOLD THE ANNUAL
VILLAGE ELECTION ON THE
FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE
FIRST MONDAY IN
NOVEMBER OF EACH YEAR

The Village Council of the Village of Kilkenny ordains:—

SECTION I.

That the Village Council of said Village of Kilkenny hereby elects to hold the Annual Election of, in, and for the said village of Kilkenny on the First Tuesday after the First Monday in November of each year.

SECTION II.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication and effective as to all Annual Village Elections held in said Village hereafter.

SECTION III.

Repeal: Any and all Ordinances, rules and resolutions contrary to this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.
