WHEREAS, purchasing agents in the U.S.A. help save lives and economy, control the expenditures of approximately a quarter trillion dollars, and

WHEREAS, through a good program of inventory control, holding the price line, and value techniques, they help curb inflation, and

WHEREAS, the Twin District is the largest district in the National Association of Purchasing Agents, with 14 associations in the district,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of MINNESOTA, do hereby proclaim the week of August 2, 1964, as

"PURCHASING AGENTS WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to note and understand the role the purchasing agent plays in our business procedures and in our economy.
