PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the President of the United States has proclaimed the week of October 4-10, 1964, as Fire Prevention Week, and
- WHEREAS, last year fires in Minnesota claimed 53 lives, seriously injured 175 and resulted in property losses amounting to \$23,995,900.60, and
- WHEREAS, experience has shown that effective community fire prevention programs can save lives and property and preserve our resources,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Roylance, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 4-10, 1964,

"FIRE PREVENTION WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge State and local government officials to join with schools, civic groups and public information agencies in promoting programs that will remind us all of our responsibility to assist in eliminating this careless waste of life and property.
