of Montezuma.

Section 1. That pursuant to that certain petition signed by all of the owners of the land hereinafter described, in Washington County, Minnesota, containing less than two hundred acres, situated on the Western side of the Village of Montezuma, requesting the annexation of said land to said village, said petition having been duly filed with the Clerk of said village and it appearing that such annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected, the village boundaries of the Village of Montezuma are hereby extended to include said land described as follows:

All that part of Lot one (1), Section twenty-nine (29), Township thirty (30) North, Range twenty-one (21), described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point on the North line of Block twelve (12) of Bohemian (now vacated), as surveyed and platted and on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Minnesota, two hundred (200) feet west of the northeast corner of said block; running thence west along the north line of said block two hundred and twenty-one hundredths (200.21) foot to a point running thence southerly along the easterly line of the Minneapolis & St. Paul Suburban Railway Company right-of-way five hundred twelve and two tenths (512.2) feet to a point; running thence east on a line parallel with said north line four hundred fifty-six (456) feet to a point on the east line of said block, which point is five hundred nine (509) feet south of the northeast corner of said block; running thence north along said east line three hundred fifty-nine feet (359) to a point which is one hundred fifty (150) feet south of said northeast corner; running thence west on a line parallel with said north line two hundred (200) feet to a point; running thence north on a line parallel with said east line to the point of beginning; said tract being a part of the north five (5) acres of said Block twelve (12) of Bohemian (now vacated), described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of the above described tract; thence running north along the east line of said above described tract a distance of one hundred ninety-nine (199) feet to a point; thence west on a line parallel with the south line of the above described tract a distance of two hundred (200) feet to a point; thence south on a line parallel with the east line a distance of one hundred ninety-nine (199) feet to a point on the south line of the above described tract; thence east along the south line of the above described tract a distance of two hundred (200) feet to the point of beginning.

and that said territory is hereby made a part of the Village of Montezuma as effectually as if the same had originally been a part of said Village.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon the filing of a certified copy thereof with the County Auditor of Washington

County and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota and with the
Minnesota Municipal Corporation and from and after its publication.


