WHEREAS, highways, water ways, refuse collection and disposal, sewage disposal systems, traffic control, public buildings and other facilities and services are vital to our way of life and standard of living, and

WHEREAS, these facilities and services are constructed, maintained, operated and administered by units of the federal, state and local governments, and

WHEREAS, these public works functions, so important to the health and well-being of our citizens, are performed by dedicated administrators, engineers and other employees working for the several governments, and

WHEREAS, a better understanding by the people of this State of the nature of public works and its value to the community will materially influence the retaining and attracting of qualified and dedicated personnel to staff public works departments,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolavaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 14- October 4, 1964, as

NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK

In Minnesota, and call upon all citizens and civic organizations to acquaint themselves with the problems involved in providing the public works facilities and services desired by the people, and to recognize the important role in our safety, health, and well being that is played by the public works officials of our State.

I, KARL F. ROLAVAG, do hereby proclaim and cause the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four and of the State, the one hundred seventh.
