PROCLAMATION NO. 17194

WHEREAS, the preservation and encouragement of the accordion, both as an educational and recreational instrument, is one of the principal aims of the Minnesota Accordion Guild; and

WHEREAS, educating the ethical and cultural standards of those interested in the accordion as a student, teacher, studio operator and enthusiast is an ongoing program; and

WHEREAS, in carrying on its program, the Minnesota Accordion Guild is sponsoring a Music Festival in Minneapolis on August 22 and 23, 1964; and

WHEREAS, over 600 contestants have enrolled in the various categories coming from every corner of the State of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polkay, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 22 and 23, 1964, as

"ACCORDION DAYS"

In Minnesota, and do urge all citizens to enjoy and appreciate the music and the efforts of the Minnesota Accordion Guild.
