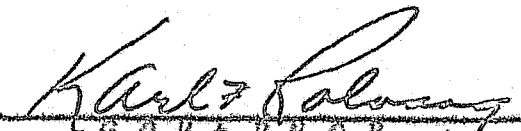
WHEREAS, over 600 contestants have enrolled in the various categories coming from every corner of the State of Minnesota,

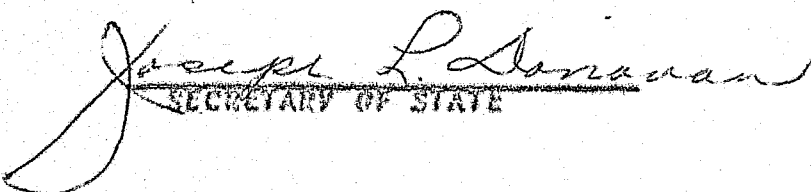
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 22 and 23, 1964, as

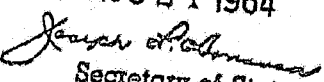
"ACCORDION DAYS"
