ORDINANCE NO. 304

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED AGRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesote by the sole owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesote, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesote:
