ORDINANCE NO. 503

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE ANNUAL VILLAGE ELECTION HEREFTER FOR THE 1st TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER:

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF HINGOLEY ORDAINS:

- SECTION 1. THE ANNUAL VILLAGE ELECTION OF THE VILLAGE OF HINGOLEY SHALL HEREFTER BE HELD ON THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST MONDAY IN NOVEMBER OF EACH YEAR.
- SECTION 2. THE VILLAGE CLEM IS ORDERED TO NOTIFY THE COUNTY AUDITOR AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE ABOVE CHANGE IN TIME OF THE ANNUAL VILLAGE ELECTION.
- SECTION 3. THIS ORDINANCE BECOMES EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND PUBLICATION.
