


Herein after the village election shall be held on the same date in November as the regular elections.

ORDINANCE NO. 64

VILLAGE OF LEXINGTON  
COUNTY OF ANOKA  
STATE OF MINNESOTA

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE FIRST TUESDAY AFTER THE FIRST  
MONDAY IN NOVEMBER AS THE REGULAR VILLAGE ELECTION DATE  
COMMENCING IN THE YEAR 1964.

The Village Council of the Village of Lexington does ordain:

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes, Section 209.07, Subdivision 1, authorizes  
the Council to designate the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November as  
the regular Village election date,

AND WHEREAS, the Council believes that the change in election date  
should be made in this Village,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEXINGTON,  
MINNESOTA does ordain:

Section 1. Commencing with the 1964 Village election, the regular  
village election of Lexington shall be held annually on the first Tuesday after  
the first Monday in November of each year.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and  
publication.

Adopted by the Village Council of the Village of Lexington this 25<sup>th</sup>  
day of August, 1964.
