PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the organization, Ducks Unlimited, has, since its beginning in 1937, maintained a constant program to acquire and restore permanent breeding grounds for various species of North American waterfowl in Canada, the source of over three-quarters of all the continent's ducks, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota is the nation's leading duck hunting state because we are at the responsibility for 45% of all great "flights" here, and

WHEREAS, the members of our great brace have an obligation through Ducks Unlimited to help their own cause because the great majority of recruitment work to be done with 1964-65 funds will be done in the breeding grounds in the headlands of that great Mississippi River, and

WHEREAS, the only way hunters and conservationists have open to them to maintain the duck factories of Canada is to work together in organization like Ducks Unlimited,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl T. Rosrud, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the 2nd of 1964, as

"DUCKS UNLIMITED DAY"

In Minnesota, and I call upon the residents of this great state to lend their full support to this program in order that our sons and daughters may be witnesses to the heritage our forefathers have bequeathed to us and that we will never know extinction of the North American duck.

To witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fifth day of August in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, and of the State, the one hundred seventh.
