PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Minnesota's volunteer firemen each year perform
valuable service to their communities through assist-
ing in the prevention and control of fires, and
WHEREAS, they are deserving assistance in educating
Minnesota to the cost of preventing unnecessary
economic and human loss through fire, and
WHEREAS, it is fitting that during Fire Prevention Week which
begins October 1st, we recognize this service by
setting aside a special day for the tribute to
Minnesota's Volunteer Firemen,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Carl F. Rowley, Governor of the State of
Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the day of October 16, 1964, as

"MINNESOTA VOLUNTEER FIREMEN DAY"

and urge all citizens to honor their volunteer firemen for the
fine job they are doing and to cooperate with them for the
benefit of themselves and their fellow citizens.
