AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL ESTATE TO THE VILLAGE OF TYLER, MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Tyler does ordain as follows:

1. That all of the owners of real estate hereinafter described have petitioned the Village Council to annex to and incorporate said land in the Village of Tyler, Minnesota.
2. That said land is platted and abuts on the said Village of Tyler.
3. That it is for the best interest of all concerned that said land be so annexed to the said Village of Tyler, Minnesota.
4. That the real estate lying and being in the County of Lincoln, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot Four (4) in Block One (1) of Auditor's First Subdivision of Section Ten (10), Township One Hundred Nine (109) North, of Range Forty-four (44) west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, according to the Plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Lincoln County, Minnesota.

be, and the same hereby is annexed to and incorporated in the Village of Tyler, Minnesota.

5. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication, and upon filing of a copy of said ordinance with the Municipalities Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor of Lincoln County, Minnesota.
