IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION FOR THE DETACH-
MENT OF PROPERTY FROM THE VILLAGE OF ST. HILAIRE,
PENNINGTON COUNTY, STATE OF MINNESOTA

The petition of certain freeholders for the detachment of their property from the Village of St. Hilaire, Pennington County, Minnesota, came regularly on for hearing before the Minnesota Municipal Commission in the Village Hall in the Post Office Building at the Village of St. Hilaire, Minnesota, on the 27th day of July, 1964, at 11:00 o'clock A.M. of said day.

Robert W. Johnson, Vice-Chairman, Terrance S. O'Toole, Member, and Irving R. Keldsen, Secretary of the Municipal Commission were present in person and it was stipulated by and between the respective attorneys for the parties to this hearing that all testimony and evidence would be taken and submitted to the said Irving R. Keldsen. Joseph Warren of Red Lake Falls, Minnesota, appeared as attorney for the Village of St. Hilaire, Minnesota, and Curtis L. Charlson of Thief River Falls, Minnesota, appeared as attorney for the petitioners. Evidence was taken and testimony heard from all parties appearing at the hearing and indicating a desire to be heard. Certain exhibits and stipulations were allowed in evidence.

The Commission having considered the petition and all of the evidence and upon the files and records now makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That the petitioners Eardeen Anderson and Garnire Anderson are the owners in fee simple of the following described land lying and being in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, described as follows:

The Northeast Quarter including Lots One
and Two of Section One, Township One Hun-
dred Fifty-two, Range Forty-four

that the petitioners, Harold G. Larson and Olive M. Larson, are
the fee owners and Richard M. Dvorak and Rosemary Dvorak, husband
and wife, are the vendee purchasers under a contract for deed from
the said fee owners of the following described premises lying in
and being in the County of Pennington and State of Minnesota, des-
cribed as follows:

The Northwest Quarter including Lots Three
and Four of Section One, Township One Hun-
dred Fifty-two, Range Forty-four

2. That the aforementioned parcels of land contain 320 acres
more or less, and that all of the lands described herein were at
the time of the filing of the petition herein located and a part
of the Village of St. Hilaire, Pennington County, Minnesota, and
adjacent to the municipal boundary of the Village of St. Hilaire,
is unplatteed and occupied and used exclusively for agricultural
purposes and that said petition was signed by all of the owners
of the land described herein and affected by said petition.
3. That the detachment of said land would not unreasonably
affect the symmetry of the Village of St. Hilaire and that the
said land is not needed for reasonably anticipated future develop-
ment of the said Village of St. Hilaire.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

- A. That the lands described herein as a part of the Findings
of Fact be detached from the Village of St. Hilaire, Pennington
County, Minnesota, and the said described property is to become
a part of Black River Township, Pennington County, Minnesota.
