WHEREAS, more than 56 percent of our children are served by our school lunch program as compared with the national average of only 34 percent; and


WHEREAS, we should pay tribute to all of our citizens who participated in the school lunch program in providing the daily noon meal for our youth;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 11, 1964, as


"SCHOOL LUNCH WEEK"
