WHEREAS, the nation-wide American Landmarks Celebration will open on August 1, 1964, and run until the end of UNESCO'S International Campaign for Monuments on November 30, 1964, and

WHEREAS, this celebration has the sponsorship of many distinguished Americans including its Honorary Chairman, Mrs. Lyndon B. Johnson, and is a most worthy effort to make all of us more conscious of our state and national heritage and the culture and historic values inherent in many of the landmarks we proudly preserve; and

WHEREAS, the Action Committee for the State of Minnesota in this celebration consists of Mr. Russell Fritley, Director of the Historical Society, Chairman, Mr. H. B. Hella, Director of State Parks, and General James Marshall, Commissioner of Highways,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 28 to October 4, 1964, as

"AMERICAN LANDMARKS WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge Minnesota's adherence to the goals of this celebration and our full cooperation with its committees and officers in awakening in Minnesota a renewed interest and pride in the greatness of our historic inheritance and the necessity of its preservation in this changing world.
