P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, many years of experience in the rehabilitation and re-employment of physically and mentally handicapped persons has proven that when employed on jobs for which they are qualified, handicapped persons are useful and productive workers, and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that greater effort must be exerted in developing employment opportunities for handicapped persons, and

WHEREAS, Congress has by enactment of joint resolution approved August 11, 1946, and the President by proclamation designated October 4 to 10, 1964, as "NATIONAL EMPLOY THE HANDICAPPED WEEK", and

WHEREAS, Minnesota recognizes an obligation to provide employment for its handicapped citizens on jobs for which they are qualified.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KARL F. POLVAKO, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of October 4 to 10, 1964,

"MINNESOTA EMPLOY THE HANDICAPPED WEEK"

and urge upon all citizens the importance of cooperating in providing employment opportunities for those handicapped citizens of the State.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fifth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four and of the State, the one hundred seventh.
