WHEREAS, George Washington Carver's achievements serve as a constant reminder and a reaffirmation of our belief in brotherhood among men of all races and creeds, and
WHEREAS, men and women of all faiths and races joining in commemorating the beautiful life and service of this great scientist and humanitarian is an exception example of the American ideal of brotherhood,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, January 5, 1965, as

"GEORGE WASHINGTON CARVER DAY"
