AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF HILL CITY TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated March 31, 1964, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council of the Village of Hill City on the 14th day of April, 1964; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately sixteen (16) acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed and duly executed by all of the owners of said land; and

WHEREAS, more than thirty (30) days have elapsed since the said annexation petition was duly filed as required by law and no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board or any other source; and

WHEREAS, all the requirements of law relating thereto have been complied with; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the southern boundary thereof;

The Council of the Village of Hill City, Minnesota, ORDAINS:

Section 1.

The Hill City Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is about to become urban and suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed.

The corporate limits of the Village of Hill City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Government Lot Six (6), Section Twenty-three (23),
Township Fifty-two (52), Range Twenty-six (26),
according to the Government Survey thereof on file
and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds
of Aitkin County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing.

The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Minnesota Secretary of State, and the Aitkin County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication as required by law and upon the filing of the certified copies as direction in Section 3.
