WHEREAS, it is the duty, privilege and responsibility of every American to vote, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Allied Florists Association is cooperating with the American Heritage Foundation in a "Get Out The Vote" campaign, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period between October 6, 1964, and election day, November 3, 1964,
