WHEREAS, the United States Marine Corps has served with distinction for 189 years, from the shores of Tripoli to Iwo Jima, and

WHEREAS, the glorious accomplishments of the Marine Corps are part of our proud heritage, and

WHEREAS, November 10, 1964, marks the celebration of the 189th birthday of the United States Marine Corps, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that our civilian population honors and pays grateful tribute to our armed forces on memorable occasions,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 10, 1964,

"MARINE CORPS DAY"

in Minnesota, and call upon all citizens to display the United States Flag on this day in commemoration of all Marines, living and deceased, for their patriotism, loyalty, efficiency and devotion to duty.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-four, and of the State the one hundred seventh.
