
OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WALTER F. MONDALE, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute and upon the request of the Commissioner of Highways, do hereby constitute and appoint

EDWARD WINSTON EHLMANN

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General and fix his compensation in the sum of Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$9,750) per annum, to be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Fund. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 28th day of October, 1964.


