WHEREAS, November 22 marks the first anniversary of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polkay, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of November 13 through November 22, 1964,

"MINNESOTA TRIBUTE TO PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY"

and urge all Minnesolans to recall his sacrifice and honor his memory in a suitable manner.
