

CERTIFICATE

THE UNDERSIGNED, being the duly elected, qualified and acting Village of the Village of Moose Lake, Minnesota, does hereby certify that at the general election held on November 3rd, 1964, the question of whether or not the Village of Moose Lake wished to adopt the Optional Plan A of Village Government, was submitted to the voters of the Village.

The question submitted on ballot to the voters was as follows:

Shall Option Plan A modifying the standard plan of Village Government by providing for the appointment by the council of the clerk, treasurer and assessor, be adopted for the government of the village?

As a result of the vote on said question, there were 602 votes cast on said question. 488 Yes votes were cast and 114 No votes were cast, thus assuring the adoption of the Optional Plan A for the Village of Moose Lake and a favorable answer to the question submitted on the ballots.

That this Certificate is made to assure all persons interested and officials interested of the adoption by the Village of Moose Lake of Optional Plan A of Government as heretofore set forth.
