ORDINANCE NO. 82

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LINDSTROM, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND ADJUTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated August 26, 1964, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the 26th day of August, 1964; and

WHEREAS, said land described therein is platted and no part thereof is included within the limits of any incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the said petition was signed by all of the owners of the said land proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, copies of said petition were filed with the Municipal Commission, the County Board of Chicago County and the Town Board of Chicago Lake Township, in which Township said land is presently located, pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, no objections were filed by said Commission or said Boards within the time allowed for same by law; and

WHEREAS, no other petition for annexation including said lands is presently pending before said Municipal Commission; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the Village limits at the Southernly boundary thereof;

The Council of the Village of Lindstrom, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village and of the territory affected; (2) That the territory described herein abuts upon the Village limits, is urban in character and is suitably conditioned for Village government; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territorial Approval. The corporate limits

of the Village are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby declared to and included within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

- A. Lot 1, Block 10;
Lot 2, Block 10, and the following described portion thereof, to-wit: Commencing at the southwest corner of said Lot 1, Block 10; thence running East on the South line thereof 100 feet; thence North and parallel with the West line of said Lot 4 100 feet; thence running West and parallel with said South line of Lot 4 100 feet to the West line of said Lot 4; thence running South on the West line thereof 100 feet; to the point of beginning, in Block 5; all in Lakeland Addition according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Chicago County, Minnesota.
- B. Lot 4, Block 1, in Lakeland Addition according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Chicago County, Minnesota.
- C. Lot 3, Block 10, in Lakeland Addition according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Chicago County, Minnesota.
- D. That part of Lot 4, Block 5 of Lakeland Addition according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Chicago County, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Lot 4, Block 5; thence running East on the South line thereof 100 feet; thence North and parallel with the West line of said Lot 4 100 feet; thence running West and parallel with said South line of Lot 4 100 feet to the West line of said Lot 4; thence running South on the West line thereof 100 feet; to the point of beginning, in Block 5.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby

directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the

Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the
County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance taken effect
upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified
copies as directed in Section 3.

B. Lot 4, Block 8, in Lakeland Addition according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Chisago County, Minnesota.

C. Lot 3, Block 10, in Lakeland Addition according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Chisago County, Minnesota.

D. That part of Lot 4, Block 5 of Lakeland Addition according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the Office of the Register of Deeds in and for Chisago County, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Southwest corner of said Lot 4, Block 5; thence running East on the South line thereof 100 feet; thence North and parallel with the West line of said Lot 4 100 feet; thence running West and parallel with said South line of Lot 4 100 feet to the West line of said Lot 4; thence running South on the West line thereof 100 feet; to the point of beginning, in Block 5.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3.
