
I hereby make application for retirement as judge of the district court pursuant to M. S. 490.101, said retirement to be effective December 31, 1964.

1. That on this date I have made written application for retirement as judge of the district court to the governor, said retirement to be effective December 31, 1964. Said application is made pursuant to M.S. 490.101.

2. That I was born July 4, 1891 and attained the age of 73 years July 4, 1964.

3. That I have served as district judge continuously since September 14, 1946 and was therefore serving as a district judge at the time of the enactment of L. 1949 c. 640 coded as M.S. 490.102.

4. That in compliance with M.S. 490.102 I waive the compensation allotted to the office of district judge from December 31, 1964 to January 4, 1965 and in lieu thereof shall receive during such period and thereafter retirement pay as provided by statute.


