The annual Village Election, Tuesday November 3, 1964 a proposal to adopt Optional Plan A form of government was presented to the voters of the Village of Proctor.

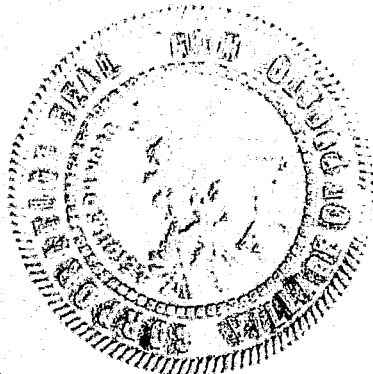
Optional Plan A
