

ORDINANCE NO. 197

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF SAUK RAPIDS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

Section 15:37 (1) A petition has been filed with the governing body of the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, by all of the owners of the following described real estate to have such land included in the Village of Sauk Rapids:

The West 80 feet of that part of Southwest 1/4 of Southwest 1/4 of Section 24, Town 36 North, Range 31 West lying North of North right-of-way of Second Street South extended Easterly and South of First Street South except the North 175.0 feet thereof;

AND ALSO

South 66 feet of West 80 feet of that part of Southwest 1/4 of Southwest 1/4 of Section 24, Town 36 North, Range 31 West lying North of South right-of-way line of Second Street South extended Easterly.

(2) The quantity of land embraced in the foregoing description, and bounded as described is .442 acres more or less.


(3) Notice of this proposed annexation was given to the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Township of Sauk Rapids, and to the County of Benton more than 30 days previous.

(4) The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village of Sauk Rapids and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village government.


(5) Therefore, the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property herein before described by and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the Village of Sauk Rapids, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

(6) This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing Certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, and the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.

Passed by the Village Council this 2nd day of November, 1964.


