That the territory to be incorporated is that presently described as the township of Watertown in Crow Wing County, Minnesota.

That such territory is not now included within the limits of any incorporated municipality.

That such territory includes land which has been plotted into lots and blocks as provided by law and also includes unplatted lands adjoining such platted areas, which unplatted lands are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

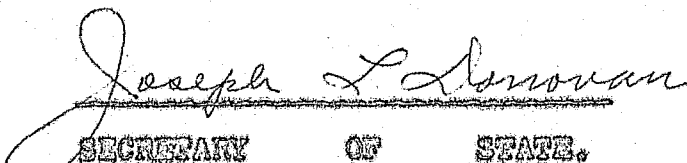

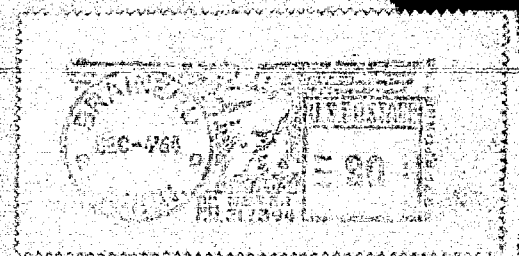

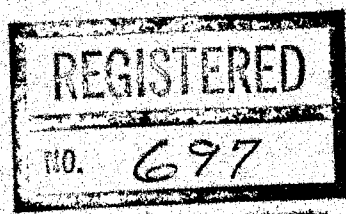
