



ORDINANCE NO. 364

AN ORDINANCE OF EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON,
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN PLATTED LAND.

The City Council of the City of Worthington Do Ordain:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate, to have such land included within the City of Worthington, Minnesota:

Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), and Eight (8), in Auditor's Plat of Block Eleven (11), of Ludlow Acres located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 26, Township 102 North, Range 40 West, Nobles County, Minnesota.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described 1.12 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Nobles County and the Board of Commissioners for Worthington Township on September 25, 1964, that said petition was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Corporation, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.
