## ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE VILLAGE OF LA CRESCENT IN HOUSTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TERRITORY ABUTTING ON SAID VILLAGE PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 414.03, MINNESOTA GENERAL STATUTES AS AMENDED

The Village Council of the Village of La Crescent, Houston County, Minnesota, ordains as follows:

- 1. Independent School District No. 300, a duly organized school district under the laws of the State of Minnesota, as the sole owner of the real estate hereinafter described, duly petitioned the Village Council of this Village to have said real estate annexed to and included within said Village.
