

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE ANNEKING TO THE VILLAGE OF LA CRESCENT
IN HOUSTON COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TERRITORY ABUTTING ON
SAID VILLAGE PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION
414.03, MINNESOTA GENERAL STATUTES AS AMENDED

The Village Council of the Village of La Crescent, Houston County,
Minnesota, ordains as follows:

1. Independent School District No. 300, a duly organized school district under the laws of the State of Minnesota, as the sole owner of the real estate hereinafter described, duly petitioned the Village Council of this Village to have said real estate annexed to and included within said Village.
2. Said real estate abuts on said Village, is not included in any other municipality, is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres in area.
3. The annexation of said real estate to said Village will be to the best interests of said Village, of said real estate, and of the territory affected thereby.
4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 414.03, Minnesota General Statutes as amended, it is hereby declared that the real estate hereinafter described is hereby annexed to, included within and made a part of the Village of La Crescent in Houston County, Minnesota, said real estate being situate in said County of Houston and described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the northwest quarter of Section 15 in Township 104 North of Range 4 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian described as commencing at a point of beginning described as commencing at the northwest corner of the northwest quarter of said Section 15, thence south 89 degrees 11 minutes east 607.3 feet along the north line of said Section 15, thence south 23 degrees 34 minutes east 1,145.1 feet to the point of beginning of the tract of land to be described, running thence south 23 degrees 34 minutes east 80 feet, thence south 45 degrees 24 minutes west 351 feet, thence north 21 degrees 45 minutes west 176.3 feet, thence north 60 degrees 56 minutes east 324.3 feet to the place of beginning.

5. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and adoption and publication as provided by law and its filing as provided by Chapter 414, Minnesota General Statutes as amended.

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

TO THE VILLAGE OF LA CRESCENT, MINNESOTA

TO THE HONORABLE VILLAGE COUNCIL
VILLAGE OF LA CRESCENT, MINNESOTA:

The petitioner Independent School District No. 300 for its petition to your honorable body respectfully represents and states:

1. The petitioner Independent School District No. 300 is a duly organized independent school district under the laws of the State of Minnesota.
2. The petitioner is the absolute owner of the fee simple title to the following described tract of land situate in the Town of La Crescent in the County of Houston and State of Minnesota, to-wit:

That part of the northwest quarter of Section 15 in Township 104 North of Range 4 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian described as commencing at a point of beginning described as commencing at the northwest corner of the northwest quarter of said Section 15, thence south 89 degrees 11 minutes east 607.3 feet along the north line of said Section 15, thence south 23 degrees 34 minutes east 1,145.1 feet to the point of beginning of the tract of land to be described, running thence south 23 degrees 34 minutes east 80 feet, thence south 45 degrees 24 minutes west 351 feet, thence north 21 degrees 45 minutes west 176.3 feet, thence north 60 degrees 56 minutes east 324.3 feet to the place of beginning.

3. The above described tract of land owned by the petitioner is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres in area; said tract of land abuts the Village of La Crescent, Minnesota, an incorporated municipality under the laws of the State of Minnesota, and is not included in any other municipality; the boundaries of no other municipality abut upon the boundaries of said tract of land.

4. Said tract of land adjoins a tract of land heretofore acquired by the petitioner as a site for a new high school for the School District, which high school site was recently annexed to said Village of La Crescent in two parts pursuant to the petitions to said Village by this School District.

5. The annexation of said tract of land to said Village of La Crescent will be to the best interest of the Village of La Crescent and of the territory affected.

6. The School Board of Independent School District No. 300 adopted a resolution on the 29th day of September, 1964 determining to petition for the annexation of this tract of land to the Village of La Crescent and directing the Chairman of the School Board and the School District Clerk to execute this

petition for that purpose, a true, correct and complete copy of which resolution is hereto attached and marked Exhibit A.

7. This petition is made pursuant to the provisions of Subdivision 2 of Section 414.03, Minnesota General Statutes as amended.

WHEREFORE, Independent School District No. 300 hereby petitions your honorable body to have the above described tract of land owned by the petitioner included within, annexed to and made a part of the Village of La Crescent, Minnesota.

RESOLUTION DETERMINING TO PETITION FOR ANNEXATION
OF LAND TO VILLAGE OF LA CRESCENT, MINNESOTA

BE IT RESOLVED, By the School Board of Independent School District No. 300 as follows:

1. This school district is the absolute owner of the fee simple title to the following described tract of land situated in the Town of La Crescent in the County of Houston, State of Minnesota, to-wit:

That part of the northwest quarter of Section 15 in Township 104 North of Range 4 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian described as commencing at a point of beginning described as commencing at the northwest corner of the northwest quarter of said Section 15, thence south 89 degrees 11 minutes east 607.3 feet along the north line of said Section 15, thence south 23 degrees 34 minutes east 1,145.1 feet to the point of beginning of the tract of land to be described, running thence south 23 degrees 34 minutes east 80 feet, thence south 45 degrees 24 minutes west 351 feet, thence north 21 degrees 45 minutes west 176.3 feet, thence north 60 degrees 55 minutes east 324.3 feet to the place of beginning.

2. The above described tract of land is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres in area; said tract of land abuts the Village of La Crescent, Minnesota, an incorporated municipality under the laws of the State of Minnesota, and is not included in any other municipality; and the boundaries of no other municipality abut upon the boundaries of said tract of land.

3. It is hereby determined and declared that this district shall petition the Village Council of the Village of La Crescent, Minnesota, to have the above described tract of land owned by the district included within, annexed to and made a part of said Village of La Crescent pursuant to the provisions of Subdivision 2 of Section 414.03, Minnesota General Statutes as amended; the Chairman of the School Board and the School District Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to make a petition to said Village of La Crescent on behalf of and in the name of this school district accordingly.
