
OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General in the Department of Conservation for the period commencing December 30, 1964, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said LAWRENCE J. VAUBEL as such Special Assistant Attorney General at the sum of Eleven Thousand Dollars (\$11,000) per year, to be paid from the appropriation for the Department of Conservation.






