PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, voluntary programs of individual and organization action to achieve EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN HOUSING to eradicate racial and religious discriminatory practices from all communities in peaceful, imaginative and orderly ways is of the utmost importance and urgency, and

WHEREAS, the President has repeatedly urged educational programs by civic, educational, religious, industry, labor and other non-government groups to eliminate the basic causes of discrimination, and

WHEREAS, as long as these are housing discrimination practices destructive to the human values of the community, the moral and spiritual life of America cannot be supported,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Polvaco, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 18-20, 1965, as

"EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN HOUSING DAYS"

In Minnesota, and urge wide participation in the NATIONAL ASSEMBLY FOR PROGRESS IN EQUAL OPPORTUNITY IN HOUSING in Springfield, Illinois, March 18-20, 1965, as one means of attack on one of the most destructive of discriminatory practices existing in the LAND OF OPPORTUNITY.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-five and of the State, the one hundred seventh.
