

ORDINANCE NO. 50.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LOTS AND BLOCKS TO  
THE VILLAGE OF HAWLEY.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF HAWLEY, CLAY COUNTY,  
MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. That the lots and blocks described as follows:

All of Blocks one (1), four (4) and five  
(5), and the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Blocks two (2),  
three (3) and six (6), of Works' First Addition  
to the Village of Hawley, Clay County, Minnesota,

abutting upon the incorporated village of Hawley, be, and the same are  
hereby, annexed to such Village and shall become a part of such Village  
as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof.
