PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, snow skiing is a major sport and recreation in the United States of America and is enjoyed by millions of citizens, and

WHEREAS, the sport encourages active physical participation in competitive and recreational events by our younger citizens, thereby aiding them in becoming better citizens of the United States of America and their local communities, and

WHEREAS, the growth of the sport has stimulated the economic development of many parts of our nation and provided untold benefits to our citizens and the growth of our country, and

WHEREAS, our National ski teams under the sponsorship of the United States Ski Association and its divisional association have represented the United States of America in International and Olympic competition with honor and prestige, and

WHEREAS, the many ski associations and industries of Recreational Services have joined together in the promotion of skiing to create a better and safer sport throughout the nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period January 12 to January 31, 1965, as

"NATIONAL SKI WEEK"

in Minnesota, and encourage our citizens to participate with others throughout the country in the special events conducted during the week for the purpose of stimulating interest in the great winter sport of skiing.
