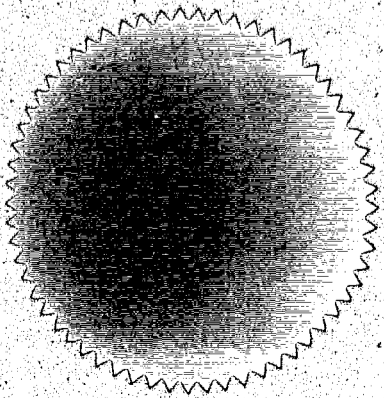

Translation.

I THE UNDERSIGNED
MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS
OF NORWAY

*Do make known by these Presents that I in order to promote the friendly inter-
course and commercial relations existing between Norway
and the United States of America*

*and by virtue of the authority vested in me by Royal Decree,
have appointed Mr. Hans HAUGEN*

to be Vice-Consul at the Royal Norwegian Consulate General in Minneapolis.

*I hereby request all authorities concerned to show him all due trust and con-
fidence and likewise render him such assistance as he may need in the exercise
of his official duties, and that they will grant him all rights and favours accorded
to Vice-Consuls of other friendly Powers in the Country where he is stationed.*
