WHEREAS, the School Safety Patrol program has just finished another year of being free from traffic fatalities charged against its operation, and

WHEREAS, this outstanding record has continued for years because of the constant vigilance of thousands of dedicated young boys and girls who protect their school mates from harm, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that all of Minnesota join to render proper honor and appreciation to the members of the school safety patrols of both our public and private schools;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week beginning February 13, 1965, as

in Minnesota, and call upon all Minnesotans to recognize these young patrol officers and give them the recognition which is their due.
