PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on March 17 the Camp Fire Girls of our nation will celebrate the 55th anniversary of the founding of this youth movement, and

WHEREAS, throughout its history Camp Fire Girls have perpetuated the organization's proud purposes of clean, wholesome youth development, and

WHEREAS, today as in the past they are demonstrating the skills and values which are so important to them as future women voters of this great nation, and

WHEREAS, this non-sectarian, interracial organization, Camp Fire Girls from seven through high school age emphasizes ideals as well as activities, and encourages in girls beauty of spirit, warm human relationships, and an appreciation of the wonders of the world around them,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Karl F. Rolvaag, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do proclaim the week of March 21 - 27, 1965, as

"CAMP FIRE BIRTHDAY WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge public recognition for this organization of girls and young women active in the service of our communities.
